



## QUALIFICATIONS FOR THE STATE UNIVERSITY OF NEW YORK AT BUFFALO or BUFFALO STATE COLLEGE SCHOLARSHIP AWARD

To receive this \$2,400.00 cash award, the successful applicant must meet and comply with the following conditions:

1. He/She must be a resident of either Erie or Niagara County in the State of New York and be graduated from a high school in either of these two counties.
2. He/She must be accepted in the Engineering School of the State University of New York at Buffalo or Buffalo State College beginning with the first semester of his/her first year in the fall following graduation from high school in an engineering course requiring four years of eight full semesters for completion leading to a degree in engineering.
3. He/She will be selected finally by the Directors of the Engineering Society of Buffalo, Inc. who will be guided by the recommendations of the Scholarship Committee. This Committee will base its recommendations upon the applicant's past scholastic record, leadership ability, potential, desire and personality.
4. He/She must continue with his/her four-year course at SUNYAB or Buffalo State without interruption in order to receive the full amount of the scholarship. However, if after the first semester circumstances should make it impossible for the student to continue their attendance without interruption, the Directors of Engineering Society of Buffalo, Inc. will give consideration to easing this regulation in order that the spirit of the award be continued. The Engineering Society of Buffalo, Inc. reserves the right to cancel the scholarship if in any semester the recipient is registered in less than 12 hours of work, if the recipient is not pursuing course work acceptable toward a degree in engineering, or if the recipient's record is such as to place them on probation for a second consecutive time.
5. When the successful applicant has been certified by the Dean of the Engineering School of the State of University of New York at Buffalo or Buffalo State as duly enrolled for the fall semester following their graduation from high school, the Engineering Society of Buffalo, Inc. will present to him/her the sum of \$300.00. (This is usually at the Past President's Dinner held in September). A like sum will be sent to him/her upon similar certification at the beginning of successive semesters, as long as he/she complies with paragraph 4, until the total of \$2,400 has been paid to this one student.
